



Using Haptics at a Coffee Shop

A young girl brings coffee and a pastry bag to a woman seated at a table.

The girl uses Haptics to inform the woman where she has placed her coffee and pastry on the table.

The signal for “food” is made followed by the directional signal “to the left.” The woman reaches for her pastry. The signal for “drink,” then the signal for “coffee” is made followed by the directional signal for “to the right.” The woman reaches out and takes her coffee.
